1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN CELL PHONE VOICE
2	COMMUNICATIONS.
3	(a) In General.—Subchapter I of chapter 417 of
4	title 49, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
5	end the following:
6	"§ 41725. Prohibition on certain cell phone voice com-
7	munications
8	"(a) Prohibition.—The Secretary of Transpor-
9	tation shall issue regulations—
10	"(1) to prohibit an individual on an aircraft
11	from engaging in voice communications using a mo-
12	bile communications device during a flight of that
13	aircraft in scheduled passenger interstate or intra-
14	state air transportation; and
15	"(2) that exempt from the prohibition described
16	in paragraph (1) any—
17	"(A) member of the flight crew on duty on
18	an aircraft;
19	"(B) flight attendant on duty on an air-
20	craft; and
21	"(C) Federal law enforcement officer act-
22	ing in an official capacity.
23	"(b) Definitions.—In this section, the following
24	definitions apply:
25	"(1) Flight.—The term 'flight' means, with
26	respect to an aircraft, the period beginning when the

1	aircraft takes off and ending when the aircraft

3	"(2) Mobile communications device.—
4	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The term 'mobile
5	communications device' means any portable
6	wireless telecommunications equipment utilized
7	for the transmission or reception of voice data.

10	stalled on an aircraft.".
