Dear Chairman Boxer, Chairman Shuster, and Ranking Members Vitter and Rahall:

The American Gas Association (AGA) commends your bipartisan leadership in bringing to closure the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 (WRRDA) Conference. AGA represents more than 200 local energy companies that deliver clean natural gas throughout the United States, and it is on their behalf that I write to urge swift adoption of the Conference Report by the House and Senate.

In particular, I would like to applaud the conferees for including within the final Report the following AGA priority issue:

**Section 1006, Expediting the Evaluation and Processing of Permits.** The provision provides the U.S. Corps of Engineers with permanent authority to enter cost-recovery agreements with non-federal government entities, electric utilities and U.S. natural gas companies for the review of permit applications. The availability of mutually agreeable, fair and practical cost recovery agreements with the Corps will provide a more transparent, timely and predictable review of permit applications and further the effort to safely, reliably and affordably serve energy customers.

On behalf of natural gas utilities from around the country, AGA thanks you for your leadership. We urge all members of the House and Senate to vote <u>in support</u> of the WRRDA 2014 Conference Report.
