
**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF
THE UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alteration project for the Jack Brooks Federal Building, U.S. Post Office and Courthouse at 300 Willow Street in Beaumont, Texas, to address the building's deteriorating envelope and mitigate impact of humid climate; modernize outdated mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems; preserve historic attributes; repair damaged portions of the interior; and undertake site and life-safety improvements, for an additional cost of \$5,431,000, and for a new total project cost of \$92,132,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved. This resolution amends Prospectus No. PTX-0019-BE24.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
