The American Association of Port Authorities (AAPA) commends you for your leadership in getting water infrastructure legislation through your respective chambers. AAPA would like to express its support for America's Water Infrastructure Act (AIWA) and urge you to quickly take up and pass the legislation. AIWA will continue the biennial process of water resources legislation to authorize navigation channel improvements, expedite engineering and design for qualifying projects and approve new channel improvement studies. The legislation also streamlines Corps of Engineers processes, empowers nonfederal-led studies and construction work and increases stakeholder participation in Corps policy development.

American seaport activity accounts for over a quarter of the economy and supports more than 23 million American jobs. Seaports are economic engines and vital freight gateways to the global marketplace for American farmers, manufacturers, and serve as critical infrastructure for the U.S. military. Our nation's ability to address the trade needs of both today and the future are at risk. Seaport infrastructure investments are good for ports and good for the nation.
