2	Section 502(7) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-
3	trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1362(7)) is amended—
4	(1) by striking "(7) The term" and inserting
5	the following:
6	"(7) Navigable waters.—
7	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The term"; and
8	(2) by adding at the end the following:
9	"(B) Exclusions.—The term 'navigable
10	waters' does not include—
11	"(i) waste treatment systems, includ-
12	ing treatment ponds or lagoons designed to
13	meet the requirements of this Act;
14	"(ii) ephemeral features that flow only
15	in direct response to precipitation;
16	"(iii) prior converted cropland;
17	"(iv) groundwater; or
18	"(v) any other features determined to
19	be excluded by the Administrator or the
20	Secretary of the Army, acting through the
21	Chief of Engineers.".
