



**EAA's Statement on the *Introduction of the Airspace Location and Enhanced Risk Transparency (ALERT) Act***

The Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) welcomes the introduction of the *Airspace Location and Enhanced Risk Transparency (ALERT) Act*. The Act provides a comprehensive and targeted approach to addressing the National Transportation Safety Board's recommendations resulting from the tragic events of January 29, 2025, at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport. The provisions in the ALERT Act direct the FAA to leverage technology, industry expertise, and lessons learned to improve safety while allowing flexibility and considering the needs of the various users of the National Airspace System. EAA is grateful to the leadership and staff of the House Transportation & Infrastructure and House Armed Services Committees for their development of this Act and remains committed to working with Congress to develop and implement safety enhancements that benefit users of the National Airspace System.
