Amendment to H.R. 5303 Offered by Mr. Farenthold of Texas

At the end of title I, add the following:

1 SEC. ____. REIMBURSEMENT COSTS OF CERTAIN PRIVATE 2 AID-TO-NAVIGATION PROJECTS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and subject to subsections (b) and (c) and 4 5 the availability of appropriated funds, the Commandant 6 of the Coast Guard may reimburse a non-Federal entity 7 for costs incurred by the entity for a project to establish a private aid to navigation that is determined by the Com-8 9 mandant to be required as a result of the completion of a Corps of Engineers dredging or channel alteration 10 11 project.

12 (b) CONDITIONS.—The Commandant may not pro-13 vide such reimbursement for a project unless—

- (1) the Commandant approves the design of the
 project before construction under the project begins;
 (2) all permits required for the project under
 Federal and State law have been issued; and
- (3) the Commandant determines that the aid to
 navigation fulfills such additional requirements as
 may be established by the Commandant.

(c) LIMITATION ON AMOUNT.—The amount of such
 reimbursement for a project may not exceed \$5,000,000.
