

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 7659
OFFERED BY MR. GARAMENDI OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle D of title III, add the following:

**1 SEC. 354. TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN
2 EXPORTS SPONSORED BY THE SECRETARY
3 OF AGRICULTURE.**

4 Section 55314 of title 46, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b)—

7 (A) in paragraph (1) by inserting “titles I,
8 II, or III of” after “carried out under”;

9 (B) in paragraph (4) by striking “agricul-
10 tural commodities or their products” and in-
11 serting “agricultural products”;

12 (C) in paragraph (5) by striking “agricul-
13 tural commodities or their products” and in-
14 serting “agricultural products”;

15 (D) in paragraph (6) by striking “agricul-
16 tural commodities or their products” and in-
17 serting “agricultural products”;

1 (E) in paragraph (7) by striking “agricul-
2 tural commodities” and inserting “agricultural
3 products”;

4 (F) by redesignating paragraphs (4), (5),
5 (6), and (7) as paragraphs (6), (7), (8), and
6 (9), respectively; and

7 (G) by inserting after paragraph (3) the
8 following:

9 “(4) carried out under the Food for Progress
10 Act of 1985 (7 U.S.C. 1736o);

11 “(5) carried out under the McGovern-Dole
12 International Food for Education and Child Nutri-
13 tion Program under section 3107 of the Farm Secu-
14 rity and Rural Investment Act of 2002 (7 U.S.C.
15 1736o–1);” and

16 (2) by adding at the end the following:

17 “(d) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—At least once each
18 fiscal year, the Secretary of Agriculture or the Adminis-
19 trator of the United States Agency for International De-
20 velopment, as applicable, shall submit to the appropriate
21 congressional committees, in writing, a notice of any waiv-
22 er of the requirements of this section and the reasons for
23 granting such waiver.

24 “(e) AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT DEFINED.—In this
25 section, the term ‘agricultural product’ means any food

1 product, including an agricultural commodity (as such
2 term is defined in section 402 of the Food for Peace Act
3 (7 U.S.C. 1732(2))), specialty crop (as such term is de-
4 fined in section 3(1) of the Specialty Crops Competitive-
5 ness Act of 2004 (7 U.S.C. 1621 note)), or processed food
6 product, exported from the United States.”.
