- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Recreational Drone
- 5 Empowerment Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CLARIFYING RECREATIONAL OPERATIONS OF
- 7 DRONE SYSTEMS.
- 8 Section 44809(c)(2)(C) of title 49, United States
- 9 Code, is amended—

1	(1) in the heading by inserting "AND CLASS E"
2	after "Uncontrolled"; and
3	(2) by inserting ", Class E airspace above Class
4	G airspace, or a Class E airspace designated as an
5	extension to a Class B, Class C, Class D, or Class
6	E surface area" after "Class G airspace".
