1 SEC. ____. PROHIBITING UNCOORDINATED, UNSCHEDULED 2 WATER RELEASES.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—None of the funds appropriated 4 or otherwise made available under this Act may be used 5 by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to conduct releases 6 from U.S. Army Corps of Engineers-owned or operated 7 reservoirs, locks, dams, and other water control projects in which storage is operated and managed for authorized 8 purposes or from non-U.S. Army Corps of Engineers res-9 10 ervoirs, locks, dams, and other water control projects in 11 which storage is operated and managed for flood control 12 and navigation and subject to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' direction if the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers does 13 14 not, to the maximum extent practicable and reasonable— 15 (1) coordinate in advance with all appropriate— 16 (A) Federal, State, regional, and local gov-17 ernment officials;

18 (B) managers of interrelated projects in19 the same system;
