

**AMENDMENT**

**OFFERED BY MR. MOULTON OF MASSACHUSETTS**

At the end of Subtitle D of title X, add the following:

1 **SEC. 104 \_\_\_\_ . STUDY ON RAIL ELECTRIFICATION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Federal  
3 Railroad Administration, acting through the Associate Ad-  
4 ministrator of the Office of Research, Data, and Innova-  
5 tion, shall conduct a study on the feasibility of rail elec-  
6 trification along passenger and freight corridors across the  
7 United States.

8 (b) CONTENTS.—In conducting the study required  
9 under subsection (a), the Administrator shall identify—

10 (1) all existing and imminently planned rail cor-  
11 ridors in the United States;

12 (2) within each such corridor, with respect to  
13 each rail system—

14 (A) how such system is powered; and

15 (B) whether such system is a Class I, II,  
16 or III railroad;

17 (3) any rail corridor segments in which rail  
18 electrification may be feasible; and

1           (4) any rail corridor segments in which clean  
2 rail technologies may be adopted.

3           (c) CONSULTATION.—In carrying out the study de-  
4 scribed in this section, the Administrator shall consult  
5 with railroad owners and operators, State and local gov-  
6 ernments, and any other entities the Administrator deter-  
7 mines appropriate.

8           (d) REUSE OF RESOURCES.—In carrying out the  
9 study described in this section, the Administrator shall use  
10 any existing resources of the Administration, as applica-  
11 ble, to minimize expenditures.

12          (e) REPORT.—

13           (1) INITIAL PROGRESS REPORT.—Not later  
14 than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act,  
15 the Administrator shall submit to Congress a report  
16 on the progress of carrying out the study required  
17 under this section.

18           (2) FINAL REPORT.—Not later than 1 year  
19 after the Administrator submits the report under  
20 paragraph (1), the Administrator shall submit to  
21 Congress a final report describing the results of the  
22 study required under this section.
