On behalf of the National Stone, Sand & Gravel Association (NSSGA) and our nearly 500 member companies, I write to thank you for introducing the bipartisan *BUILD America 250 Act* and to commend the Committee for its work on this critical legislation.

NSSGA represents the producers and suppliers of crushed stone, sand and gravel: the essential construction materials that form the literal foundation of every highway, bridge, and transit project in America. Our members operate in nearly every congressional district and supply the materials that make possible the safe, efficient movement of people and goods across our nation. A timely, multi-year surface transportation reauthorization is critically important to our industry and the national economy. Long-term funding certainty enables states and localities to plan and deliver projects efficiently, sustain jobs, and support economic activity.

We appreciate the bill's prioritization for core highway formula programs, which deliver the majority of highway and bridge improvements, as well as its focus on bridge investment and provisions to improve project delivery and reduce regulatory burdens. We continue to urge Congress to pursue sustainable, user-based revenue solutions for the Highway Trust Fund's long-term stability.

We look forward to continuing to work closely with the Committee and Members of Congress as a final bill is crafted that would modernize and fund America's transportation infrastructure, while driving strong economic growth. NSSGA stands ready to provide additional information or perspectives as this legislation advances.
