RE: TCC Letter of Support for the Water Resources Development Act of 2026

Dear Chairman Graves and Ranking Member Larsen,

The 34 member organizations and labor unions of the Transportation Construction Coalition (TCC) support the Water Resources Development Act of 2026 (WRDA 2026) and urge its approval by the committee.

The predictable, biennial enactment of water resources development legislation is critical to the planning and delivery of infrastructure projects across the country. WRDA 2026 represents an important step toward addressing the nation's water infrastructure needs while supporting the ports, harbors, inland waterways, and other facilities that are essential to the safe and efficient movement of people and goods.

The bill advances projects that transportation construction firms and workers help deliver in partnership with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Civil Works program, including dredging and navigation improvements along the nation's rivers and harbors. These investments strengthen the broader transportation network, support the movement of freight, protect communities from flooding, and help ensure that infrastructure can meet current and future demands.

TCC appreciates the committee's bipartisan leadership on this legislation and looks forward to working with you as it advances through Congress.
