On behalf of the Geosynthetic Materials Association (GMA), I am writing to thank you for your leadership in working to reauthorize the Federal Aviation Administration. We applaud your dedication in ensuring that our nation's airport infrastructure continues to connect businesses and people around the world, all the while upholding the ideals of safety and economic growth.

GMA and its 70+ member companies wholeheartedly support the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018. The bill ensures the modernization of our nation's airport infrastructure through a commitment to funding the Airport Improvement Program (AIP), streamlining the Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) application process, and the assurance that our airports' diverse needs and interests will be sufficiently represented.

GMA is a division of the Industrial Fabrics Association International (IFAI), a trade association comprised of member companies representing the global specialty fabrics and advanced textiles marketplace. GMA's manufacturers and distributors are a critical element of the transportation construction supply chain as geosynthetics provide cost savings and structural integrity in airport construction and maintenance. Geosynthetics can be deployed faster than traditional materials, resulting in faster project delivery and decreased congestion at our nation's airports. GMA works regularly with the FAA William J.
