Amendment to H.R. 2997 Offered by Mr. Capuano of Massachusetts

In section 211 of the bill, in the matter proposed to be inserted as chapter 905, of title 49, United States Code, add at the end the following:

1 "§ 90507. Noise oversight and regulation of Corpora tion

"(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other pro-3 4 vision of this subtitle, the Administrator shall have the ex-5 clusive authority to resolve noise disputes and to require 6 any change in air traffic management procedures, including standard instrument departure procedures, standard 7 terminal arrival routes, and instrument approach proce-8 9 dures, or other activities of the Corporation affecting the 10 National Airspace System, when necessary to reduce noise 11 exposure.

12 "(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section the following13 definitions apply:

14 "(1) NOISE DISPUTE.—The term 'noise dispute'
15 means a dispute between an interested person and
16 the Corporation or the FAA related to aircraft noise.
17 "(2) NOISE EXPOSURE.—The term 'noise expo18 sure' means the exposure of one or more individuals

- 1 to significant or unreasonable noise levels, as deter-
- 2 mined by the Administrator.".

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
