A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to establish an axle weight tolerance for certain commercial motor vehicles transporting dry bulk goods, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DRY BULK WEIGHT TOLERANCE.
- 4 Section 127 of title 23, United States Code, is
- 5 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 6 "(x) Dry Bulk Weight Tolerance.—
- 7 "(1) Weight Tolerance.—Notwithstanding
- 8 any other provision of this section, except for the

1	maximum gross vehicle weight limitation, a commer-
2	cial motor vehicle transporting dry bulk goods may
3	not exceed 110 percent of the maximum weight on
4	any axle or axle group described in subsection (a),
5	including any enforcement tolerance.
6	"(2) Dry bulk goods defined.—In this sub-
7	section, the term 'dry bulk goods' means any homo-
8	geneous unmarked nonliquid cargo being transported
9	in a trailer specifically designed for that purpose.".
