At the end of the bill, add the following:

3 (a) APPROPRIATION.—In addition to amounts other-4 wise available, there is appropriated for fiscal year 2025, 5 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appro-6 priated, \$10,000,000,000, to remain available until ex-7 pended, for use by the Secretary of Transportation pursu-8 ant to subsection (b).

- 10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraphs (2)
  11 through (4), the Secretary may use funds made
  12 available under subsection (a) to—
- 13 (A) issue capital grants for crime preven14 tion and security, as authorized in section 5321
  15 of title 49, United States Code; or
- 16 (B) issue funds to a transit agency for use
  17 funding the operating expenses of the transit
  18 agency incurred with respect to activities—

7	(2) ELIGIBLE ENTITIES.—Funds made avail-
8	able under this section may be issued to any entity
9	eligible to receive a grant under section 5307 or

11	(3) Inclusion of operating costs for pub-
12	LIC TRANSPORTATION.—
13	(A) IN GENERAL.—Any entity that receives
14	funds pursuant to paragraph $(1)(B)$ may use
15	such funds for the operating cost of equipment
16	and facilities for use in public transportation,
17	including rail fixed guideway, if such operating
18	cost is incurred with respect to activities de-
19	scribed in paragraph (1)(B).
20	(B) PROHIBITION ON LIMITING USES
21	BASED ON POPULATION.—The Secretary may
22	not apply the limitations described in para-
23	graphs $(1)(D)$ and $(2)$ of section 5307(a) of

4	(A) CAPITAL GRANTS.—A capital grant
5	issued pursuant to paragraph $(1)(A)$ may not
6	be for an amount greater than 80 percent of
7	the net project cost of the project for which the
8	grant is issued, as determined by the Secretary.
9	(B) OPERATING EXPENSES GRANTS.—The
10	Secretary shall ensure that funds issued to an
11	entity pursuant to paragraph (1)(B) be subject
12	to a cost share requirement as described in—
13	(i) subsection $(d)(2)$ of section 5307
14	of title 49, United States Code; or
15	(ii) subsection $(g)(2)$ of section 5311
16	of title 49, United States Code.
