

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2997**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MEADOWS OF NORTH**  
**CAROLINA**

At the end of title VI, add the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . USE OF OUTCOME-BASED PERFORMANCE STAND-**  
2 **ARDS.**

3 (a) **COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW.**—The Administrator  
4 of the Federal Aviation Administration shall conduct a  
5 comprehensive review of the regulations, guidance, and  
6 policies of the Administration to identify those regulations,  
7 guidance, and policies that—

8 (1) in current form, establish prescriptive re-  
9 quirements for regulated entities; and

10 (2) are able to be replaced, consistent with Fed-  
11 eral law, with outcome-based performance standards.

12 (b) **REPORT AND PLAN.**—Not later than 120 days  
13 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator  
14 shall submit to Congress a report on the results of the  
15 comprehensive review conducted under subsection (a) that  
16 includes—

17 (1) a list identifying each prescriptive regula-  
18 tion, guidance document, and policy that was deter-

1       mined by the Administrator to be able to be replaced  
2       with an outcome-based performance standard;

3           (2) a detailed plan to replace the regulations,  
4       guidance, and policies identified under paragraph  
5       (1) with outcome-based performance standards;

6           (3) a justification for omitting the regulations,  
7       guidance, and policies not identified under para-  
8       graph (1); and

9           (4) legislative recommendations to facilitate ad-  
10      ditional replacement opportunities.

11      (c) PLAN IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 2 years  
12      after the date on which the report required under sub-  
13      section (b) is submitted to Congress, the Administrator  
14      shall complete implementation of the plan described in  
15      that subsection.

16      (d) RULEMAKING REQUIREMENT.—

17           (1) IN GENERAL.—To the maximum extent pos-  
18      sible, the Administrator shall ensure that regula-  
19      tions, guidance, and policies issued by the Adminis-  
20      tration on and after the date of enactment of this  
21      Act are issued in the form of outcome-based per-  
22      formance standards and not as prescriptive require-  
23      ments for regulated entities.

24           (2) JUSTIFICATIONS.—The Administrator shall  
25      make available to the public a justification for each

1 regulation, guidance document, and policy issued by  
2 the Administration on and after the date of enact-  
3 ment of this Act that is not issued in the form of  
4 an outcome-based performance standard.
