 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

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1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Reducing Permitting3 Uncertainty Act".

4 SEC. 2. PERMITS FOR DREDGED OR FILL MATERIAL.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 404(c) of the Federal
6 Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1344(c)) is
7 amended—

8 (1) by striking "(c) The Administrator" and in-9 serting the following:

10 "(c) SPECIFICATION OR USE OF DEFINED AREA.—
11 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator";

(2) in paragraph (1), as so designated, by inserting "during the period described in paragraph
(2) and" before "after notice and opportunity for
public hearings"; and

16 (3) by adding at the end the following:

"(2) Period of prohibition.—

18 "(A) IN GENERAL.—The period during 19 which the Administrator may prohibit the speci-20 fication (including the withdrawal of specifica-21 tion) of any defined area as a disposal site, or 22 deny or restrict the use of any defined area for 23 specification (including the withdrawal of speci-24 fication) as a disposal site, under paragraph (1) 25 shall-

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1	"(i) begin on the date that the Sec-
2	retary provides notice to the Administrator
3	that the Secretary has completed all proce-
4	dures for processing an application for a
5	permit under this section relating to the
6	specification and is ready to determine, in
7	accordance with the record and applicable
8	regulations, whether the permit should be
9	issued; and
10	"(ii) end on the date on which the
11	Secretary issues the permit.
12	"(B) MINIMUM PERIOD.—The Secretary
13	shall ensure that the period described in sub-
14	paragraph (A) consists of not fewer than 30
15	consecutive days.
16	"(C) NOTICE.—The Secretary may issue a
17	permit under this section only after the Sec-
18	retary provides notice to the Administrator in
19	accordance with this paragraph.".
20	(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
21	section (a) shall apply to a permit application submitted
22	under section 404(a) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-
23	trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1344(a)) after the date of enactment
24	of this Act.
