At the end of title VI, add the following:

5	tation shall enter into an agreement with an institution
6	of higher learning to conduct a study on the training re-
7	ceived by customer-facing employees of air carriers.
8	(b) Contents.—The study shall include—
9	(1) an analysis of the effectiveness of the train-
10	ing received by customer-facing employees with re-
11	spect to the management of disputes on aircraft; and
12	(2) an examination of how institutions of higher
13	learning, in coordination with air carriers, customer-
14	facing employees and their representatives, consumer
15	advocacy organizations, and other stakeholders,
16	could —
17	(A) review such training and related prac-
18	tices;
19	(B) produce recommendations; and
20	(C) provide supplemental training.

- 2 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
