RE: 2022 Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) Legislation

Dear Chairs DeFazio and Napolitano and Ranking Members Graves and Rouzer:

Thank you for your leadership in ports, transportation and goods movement, especially as we continue to address the impacts of the global COVID-19 pandemic.

The Port of Long Beach (Port) supports the draft 2022 Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) before you this Congressional session. Constructing and maintaining federal navigation channels are critical for our national goods movement industry to thrive. Passage of a WRDA 2022 that will authorize new construction projects and studies, as well as streamline Army Corps of Engineers' processes, will play a key role in sustaining and growing our nation's ports, which move approximately \$6 billion worth of goods daily. In addition to more throughput, some navigation projects, like our Deep Draft Navigation Project, will also result in reductions of air pollutants and greenhouse gasses by increasing navigational efficiency and facilitating next generation vessels with increased cargo capacity and cleaner engines, resulting in fewer emissions and cleaner air quality for communities surrounding ports.

Again, thank you for your leadership. We look forward to continue working with you and your Committee staff on the passage of 2022 WRDA legislation.
